**ICIT Committee Activities:**

**Legislative:** Travis Gerrish reported on HF2288 cyber and tech now county purpose for funding

**Membership, Nominations & Awards:** Andy McGill Getting things set up for some awards at ITAG

**Education and Schools:** Sarah Haberl reported on then Micah Van Maanen spoke about registration starting next week, June 14-17 ITAG

**Online Services:** Micah Van Maanen had nothing specific to report, trying to update email addresses as they change

**GIS Data Repository:** Nothing new to report, been working flawlessly

**Information Security:** Joel Rohne reported said covered it with monthly calls, security committee, etc. Jess Flaherty main contact for OCIO. Cyberstorm national cyber exercise, some members participated, NACO has been doing quarterly cyber exercises you can participate in.

**Scholarship Committee:** Alissa Holtz reported two scholarship winners: \$1,500 was awarded to Stren Crouch who is going to Iowa State for Aerospace Engineering and Bryce Olson was awarded \$500 and is going to Northwest Iowa Community College for Welding Technology, Kim Veeder was on the committee so since she retired someone else could join the committee. December 3<sup>rd</sup> is deadline to apply for the next one.

**Tech Service Bureau Advisory Committee:** Micah Van Maanen speaking on behalf of committee, 2019 exploratory committee was formed to find ways for help with tech teams etc, find someone to take some of this workload, midyear 2021 board meeting, plan presented by Eric Guth and get funding secured. Before this happened had a strategic planning meeting, initial plan was to get a contractor to go find grant dollars for this position, in December 2021 spoke with ISAC and Brad Holtan about the needs and what we wanted to get out of this position tech service bureau, using GISDR leftover grant funds to help fund the beginning and have our place at the table, direct input by serving on the board and come up with job description for the position starting in July

**Open the floor for discussion for using the grant money for the tech service bureau, Andy McGill spoke on ICIT funds (Alissa Holtz said balance \$39,000 or so) and that 20 some counties using current gisdr and very well maintained and not a ton of data being stored.** It's not a lot of money to be spent for upkeep or having to move to another county to host. Put the money to good use to benefit all 99 counties and this can help get this going. It's designed to help both IT & GIS. Jeff Miller asked on our normal account balance, \$26,000 or so balance. Micah Van Maanen explained ISAC part of that position is funding moving forward and this grant money to help tech service bureau get this rolling and get more funding. ISAC backing it is huge plus.

**OCIO Security Advisory Committee:** Joel Rohne reported on OCIO hired a CISO Shane Dwyer and he has pretty ambitious things for security in Iowa, Advisory Governance Committee, National Guard, Secretary of State, OCIO, County, City involvement, CrowdStrike 25k licenses purchased, will be replacing Fireeye eventually, possibly this year for counties but for sure next year he is going to go back to governor to ask for more ARPA funding to buy more. Critical response team assembled for Iowa and will be part of it moving forward.

#### **Organization updates:**

**ISAC Executive Board:** Tech Service Bureau approved, ISAC dues going up \$200 to \$6,100 per county, events like school will be going up. High performance leadership geared toward it now available.

**Iowa Land Records:** Eric Sloan nothing to report

**CIAO:** Nothing new to report, haven't had any meetings.

**IGIC:** Penny Vossler said by-law changes, outreach to schools and promoting ESRI class opportunities. Magic Conference coming up April 11-14 in Branson have IGIC submit call for presentations for ITAG. Lunch and learns monthly.

**EIGIS:** Nothing new to report, haven't had any meetings.

**Tech Team:** Micah Van Maanen will be requesting project for Monona County, Joel Rohne reported end of March, helping Humboldt now and will be posting job, 70-80k start, Van Buren County conversations through cyber workshop, Montgomery County assisted with hiring, Audubon two assessments so far and helping to hire someone. Gabe Johanns and Joel Rohne assisting with.
